Ronald W. Kaese, M.B.A., M.S., M.E., Director, Federal Programs, Maryland Technology Development Corporation (TEDCO) came to TEDCO from the NASA Goddard Space Flight Center, where he retired after 32 years of government service. He has worked primarily in an R&D environment within the U.S. Army and NASA. While assigned to the NASA Goddard Technology Commercialization Office (TCO) he served as the Acting Chief of TCO, re-engineered the Software Release Process and records system, and revamped the Patent Office Technology Licensing files. Mr. Kaese's work experience also includes serving in the U.S. Air Force and working in the COMSAT Labs, U.S. Army Materiel Command and USAREUR, and the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development, Investment Finance Group.
