About the 2008 FLC MAR Awards

The FLC MAR Awards Program annually recognizes federal laboratories and their industry partners for outstanding technology transfer efforts.

In 2008 the FLC MAR will present awards in the following categories:

Award for Excellence in Technology Transfer – recognizes laboratory employees, and their partners, who have accomplished outstanding work in the process of transferring a technology developed by a federal laboratory.

FLC MAR Service Award – recognizes significant contributions to the FLC MAR. Awards are presented in two categories:

- **Representative of the Year Award** – for an individual FLC MAR Representative who has made the most significant contribution to the FLC MAR program in the past year.
- **Outstanding Service Award** – recognizes significant contributions to the FLC MAR. This award is for an individual who is not an FLC MAR Representative or Alternate. It is for a notable contribution to the FLC MAR in terms of sustained support and/or service.

Partnership Award – recognizes agency and/or laboratory employees who have shown extraordinary ingenuity in establishing a partnership(s)

2008 FLC MAR Award for Excellence in Technology Transfer Nomination Form

The FLC MAR Award for Excellence in Technology Transfer recognizes laboratory employees (and their partners) who have accomplished outstanding work in the process of transferring federally developed technology to the marketplace.

Each year federal laboratories submit nominations which are then carefully reviewed and scored by a panel of judges. The panelists represent federal laboratories in the MAR and have expertise in a number of areas, including medicine, engineering, marketing, agriculture, and economics. Having such a well-rounded panel results in the diversity of technology transfer efforts selected as winners.

If your laboratory has participated in technology transfer that you would like to see recognized by the FLC MAR, read the following instructions and criteria, complete the nomination form, and submit it by the deadline listed above.

2008 FLC MAR Award for Excellence in Technology Transfer Submission Guidelines

Eligibility

1. Nominee(s) must be employee(s) of FLC MAR member laboratories. A member laboratory is any federal laboratory in the MAR that is a member of the FLC and has 200 or more full-time equivalent scientific, engineering and related technical positions. The laboratory must be owned, leased, or otherwise used by a federal agency and funded by the federal government, as established under 15 U.S.C. Section 3705 or 3707. Non-laboratory staff may be included **only** when at least 50% of the transfer effort was funded by a federal laboratory **or** at least 50% of the staffing for the transfer effort was by in-house laboratory personnel. Technology transfer efforts solely funded by Small Business Innovative Research (SBIR) contracts and commercial projects 100% funded by federal grants **are not** eligible for consideration.
2. FLC MAR Laboratory Representatives or their immediate supervisors cannot be nominated; however, they can be nominated for the Representative of the Year Award and Outstanding Technology Transfer Professional Award, respectively.
3. Duplicate nominations for an individual or group are not allowed.
4. A nominee cannot be nominated for an FLC MAR Award more than three times in any year as an individual or part of a group.
5. The nominated achievement must have taken place within the last five years.

Number of Submissions

Each laboratory may submit a maximum of four nominations.

Complete Submission Procedures

A complete submission will consist of the following sections:

- A completed Submission Cover Sheet, Section 1 (4 pages)
- A completed Submission Narrative, Section 2 (4 pages)
- A completed Submission Verification Checklist, Section 3 (1 page)

General formatting for these sections should meet the following requirements:

- Use Arial or Times font styles that are no smaller than 10 points. Failure to do so will result in a disqualification of your submission.
- The completed nomination form must adhere to the electronic page format created by the FLC MAR. Alterations to margins will result in an automatic disqualification of the nomination.
- If the page limit is exceeded, your submission will be deemed invalid and returned.
- Graphics and photos are allowed to be used, provided they are included within the body of the Submission Narrative (Section 2).
- Links to URL addresses are acceptable, provided they are for online versions of patents and publications listed in Criterion A.7 (Patents and Publications) of the Submission Narrative (Section 2).
- Other supporting documentation, including brochures, news articles, press releases and URL addresses unrelated to Criterion A.7 will not be accepted with the submission.
- Although forms may be duplicated, each form must be submitted as single-sided.

Each Submission Verification Checklist must be faxed to the FLC MAR Management Support Office (attn: John Eichelberger) at **812-256-4492**. **Only the Submission Verification Checklist will be accepted by fax**, not completed submissions.

All submissions and checklists must be received by the FLC MAR Management Support Office by 5:00 p.m. EDT on **Friday, August 1, 2008**. No submissions will be accepted after this time.

The winners of the 2008 Award for Excellence in Technology Transfer will be announced at

the Awards Ceremony at the FLC MAR Annual Meeting on September 17, 2008. Laboratories submitting nominations will be notified prior to the official announcement.

Award Ceremony

All award winners will receive a keepsake from the FLC MAR commemorating their achievement. In addition, winners will be honored during an awards banquet to be held on September 17, 2008 at the FLC MAR Annual Meeting at the Rocky Gap Resort near Cumberland, Maryland.

2008 FLC MAR Award for Excellence in Technology Transfer Award Criteria

The highest score possible is 100 points. Part A, Background and Technology Transfer Process, can be worth up to 40 points, and Part B, Results, is worth up to 60 points. The total point score will be used for ranking. Scoring will be done by judging the Submission Narrative (Section 2) against the criteria listed below.

FLC Laboratory Representatives should carefully review the award criteria before preparing a nomination. It is important to understand that this award is specifically for **transferring technologies**; they are **not** given for a research effort that does not include an element of technology transfer—no matter how innovative it might be.

Because each item of the award criteria is worth points, each criterion in Part A and Part B must be addressed in the Submission Narrative. If an item is not applicable, please indicate this in the narrative, and this will be taken into account by the judges. When writing your Submission Narrative, be as specific and concise as possible.

Carefully review the award criteria before writing your Submission Narrative. How closely you adhere to the guidelines provided may be the deciding factor in whether your laboratory is selected as a winner!

Criteria Part A – Background and Technology Transfer Process

- 1. Description of Technology (5 points)**
 - a. What technology was transferred?
 - b. Briefly describe features of the technology, benefits, and limitations.
- 2. Technology Transfer Recipients and Technology Need (7 points)**
 - a. Who or what was the recipient of the transferred technology?
 - b. Why was the technology needed?
 - c. What problem was solved by the technology?
- 3. Technical Expertise (5 points)**
 - a. What was the nominee(s)' involvement in the technology's development or availability (e.g. conceptualizing the technology, providing facilities and personnel to prove the technology, licensing the technology)?
- 4. Initiation of Technology Transfer Partnership (10 points)**
 - a. Was the partnership for the technology initiated by the laboratory, the company or other entity?
 - b. Why was a federal laboratory the best place to achieve the transfer?
 - c. What were the specific roles, goals, objectives, and expectations of each partner?
 - d. How well were the goals and expectations met?

5. Technology Transfer Processes and Innovations Used (5 points)

- a. What technology transfer processes (e.g. CRADAs, patents, licensing) were used to transfer the technology?
- b. To what extent did the federal laboratory fund the technology transfer effort?
- c. Describe any innovation or creativity demonstrated by the nominee(s) in transferring the technology.

6. Time Frame Challenges (5 points)

- a. What was the time frame for the transfer? As succinctly as possible, provide a short outline of the events that led to technology transfer.
- b. Provided there was a deadline in transferring the technology, what were the major challenges in meeting the deadline?
- c. How were these challenges overcome?

7. Patents and Publications (3 points)

- a. Are there and pending patents or patents involved in this technology transfer? If applicable, cite patent (application) numbers and titles.
- b. Are there and publications involving this technology? If applicable, cite relevant references?

Criteria Part B – Results

1. New Relationships (5 points)

- a. Describe any new relationships, such as new interactions with the public or private sector, which resulted from the transfer of the technology.

2. Follow-up Activities (10 points)

- a. Describe any additional activities or applications that might be developed to meet the mission requirements of the laboratory. This might include continuing problem-solving efforts or further assistance with commercializing the technology or helping the public sector.

3. Outcome of the Technology Transfer Effort (45 points)

- a. What was the result of the technology transfer effort—a commercial product, CRADA, positive impact in the community or public sector, Spinoff Company, license?
- b. What agreements are pending and/or final regarding this technology?
- c. What are the tangible benefits of the transfer?
- d. What future benefits are expected from the transfer?
- e. Wherever possible, provide quantitative data. This includes: creation of a new industry, development of a new product, community/public sector impact, higher profit margins, cost savings, improved health and safety, environmental benefits, etc.

2008 FLC Award for Excellence in Technology Transfer Frequently Asked Questions

1. I want to nominate someone from a partnering company for this award. Would he be eligible?

Individuals affiliated with an industry partner can be nominated as part of a team that includes personnel from an FLC member laboratory.

2. One of my potential nominees is now retired/deceased. Can I still include his name in the submission?

Yes. Any individual who was employed at the laboratory/partner company at the time of the technology transfer is eligible to be nominated.

3. Is there a limit on the number of individuals I can nominate?

No. All individuals who were actively involved in the technology transfer process—with the exception of FLC Laboratory Representatives or Supervisors—can be nominated, regardless of number.

4. Our laboratory just completed a joint technology transfer effort with another laboratory. Can I submit this joint project as a nominee?

Joint technology transfer projects between federal laboratories are eligible for nomination, even if the laboratories are affiliated with different federal agencies.

5. The technology that my laboratory has produced has great potential, but has yet to be formally transferred. Can my submission be given serious consideration by the judges on basis of technology alone?

This award is given on the basis of successful technology transfer efforts, as opposed to the potential of the technology itself. It is advisable to only submit a technology for nomination once it has formally been transferred.

6. I am running behind schedule in completing my submission? Is it acceptable to send the submission after October 19, provided I make arrangements to do so in advance?

No. An electronic copy of your submission and a faxed copy of the Submission Verification Checklist must be received by the FLC MAR Management Support Office by 5:00 p.m. EDT on **Friday, August 1, 2008**. No submissions will be accepted after this time.

7. Though the deadline has passed, it has come to my attention that a section of my submission is incomplete. Can I send the missing information?

No. It is important to make sure that your submission is completed and meets the necessary requirements before you send it. The Submission Verification Checklist (Section 3) exists for this reason.

8. How will I know that my submission has been received?

Upon receipt of your submission, you will receive an electronic confirmation.

9. I have included proprietary information in my submission. If my submission is selected as a winner, can this information be deleted?

No. Keep in mind that the FLC MAR may use your entire submission as a resource document and for media purposes.

10. When will I be notified if my submission is selected as a winner?

Laboratories will be notified prior to the official public announcement of September 17, 2008. Notification will probably be made during the week of August 24th.

11. Do the winners receive a cash award?

The FLC does not distribute cash as part of award recognition.

12. Does the FLC cover travel expenses for the winner?

The FLC MAR does not cover travel expenses. However, one person/award is eligible for free registration to the FLC MAR annual meeting and all listed, winning awardees are eligible for free attendance at the awards luncheon/ceremony.

Outstanding Service Award - recognizes an individual who is not an FLC MAR Representative or Alternate for a notable contribution to the FLC MAR in terms of sustained support and/or service.

CRITERIA

1. Nominee may be an advisor, government official, university contact, etc.
2. The candidate has provided sustained support/service to the FLC MAR as an organization.
3. The contribution took place within the past three years.
4. The nominee has not previously received the award.
