Please note a significant difference between the FLC MAR and the FLC National nomination forms: While the FLC requires transfer to “the marketplace,” the FLC MAR allows transfer to the “commercial marketplace” and/or “the government marketplace.” Similarly, the requirement for the FLC Laboratory Director of the Year requires transfer “to industry” while the FLC MAR Laboratory Director of the Year allows transfer to “the commercial marketplace” and/or to “the government marketplace.”
